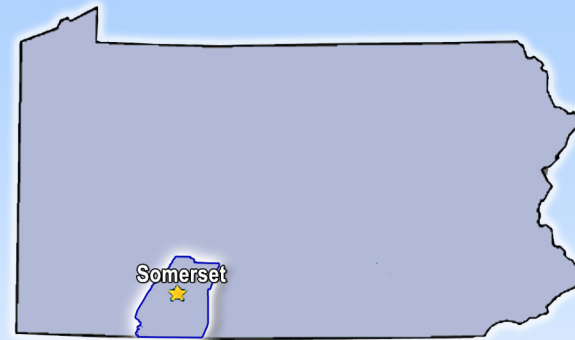

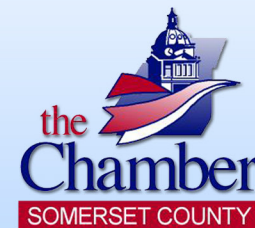


## Just a short drive away
