This course is for current and aspiring personal care administrators or nurses, caregivers, and healthcare professionals who wish to fulfill continuing education requirements. Penn State Abington's personal care home administrator training program features Pennsylvania Department of Human Services standardized and approved curriculum and consists of nineteen courses that vary in length from two to nine hours.

You must attend a one-day Department of Human Services Orientation in addition to the 100-hour course. There is no fee for the 2021 PCH Orientation.

Qualifications necessary to attend this program (must have one of the following):

- An associate degree or 60 credit hours from an accredited college or university
- A license as a registered nurse from the Pennsylvania Department of State
- A license as a licensed practical nurse from the Pennsylvania Department of State and one year of experience in a related field
- A license as a nursing home administrator from the Pennsylvania Department of State
- For a home serving eight or fewer residents, a general education development diploma or high school diploma and two years of direct care or administrative experience in the human services field

ATTENTION CURRENT PCHAs:

Each of the classes in the Personal Care Home Administrator 100-Hour Training can be taken by PCHAs toward their annual 24-credit requirement. The cost per credit hour is just \$15 and you can get your credits in the evening or Saturday.
