SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT COURSES

The Supply Chain Management courses prepare students to obtain their certification in supply management: Certified Professional in Supply Management® (CPSM®) from the Institute of Supply Management® (ISM)®. Skills and techniques learned throughout the program can be used immediately to enhance the supply chain process and improve your company's bottom line.

Designed for the purchasing practitioner (managerial/non-managerial) and professionals in forecasting and planning, logistics, operations, and warehouse/distribution, the three required courses will enhance the skills of technical competence and practical applications.

A Penn State certificate is awarded upon successful completion of the three required courses. All courses are 12 hours each. Courses can be taken individually. Students are not required to sit for the certification exam.

*These courses require a fundamental working knowledge of Supply Chain Management.
