ACAP MAKING A BIG IMPACT IN SOMERSET COUNTY

A one of a kind program to assist the agriculture community to implement natural resource conservation practices and also become more economically viable, known as the Agriculture Conservation Assistance Program (ACAP) is beginning to make a large impact in Somerset County. Funding for ACAP in Pennsylvania was authorized

by the state legislature and the program is being administered by the State Conservation Commission to conservation districts across the state. This is yet another example of the public sector providing empowerment for both economic sustainability as well as natural resource conservation in Somerset County.

In the first round of funding the Somerset Conservation District has committed \$2,204,847.00 to implement a variety of best management practices over 32 individual projects in Somerset County. A number of these projects are already under construction while others are in the design phase and will be completed over the next two years.

Among the successful applicants in the program is Dave Creamer. He describes the attributes to his farming operation as "In the past we have only been able financially to add 5 acres of grazing into our system. ACAP has given us the ability to fence 200 acres in a year's time. This would never have been possible in our lifetime without ACAP. The proj-

ect will also enable us to utilize reclaimed mine ground for pasture and improve soil health as well as control invasive species." The District's ACAP Specialist Sandra Schmidt oversees the program. Because the program is so expansive and ever changing District Nutrient Management Technician Don Williams, District Financial Manager Kristy Scarmack, District Watershed Specialist and Assistant Manager Grea Shustrick as well as District Manager Len Lichvar have all provided additional expertise and empowerment required to meet the administrative, financial and management requirements of the program.

The District ACAP committee, consisting of District Board members and staff, review all applications and the District Board of Directors makes the final approval of projects. REAL ID DEADLINE IS APPROACHING

Starting May 7, Pennsylvanians will need a REAL ID-compliant driver's license or photo ID card (or another federally accepted form of identification like a valid passport or military ID) to board domestic flights or enter federal buildings that require ID.

REAL IDs are still available and will continue to be offered after the deadline. To help residents prepare, PennDOT is hosting dedicated REAL ID Days at select Driver License Centers. On these dates, some locations can issue REAL IDs on the spot, while others will verify documents and mail the ID within 15 business days.

UPCOMING REAL ID DAYS:

April 7, April 14, April 28, & May 5 8:30 AM – 4:15 PM

Residents can also visit a REAL ID Center anytime to receive a REAL ID at the time of service, or go to any PennDOT Driver License Center to have documents verified and receive the ID by mail. Pre-verified individuals may also apply online.

Day 1: Thursday, March 5, 2026 Overnight Flight Ancient castles and Roman ruins, groves of orange and almond trees, quiet whitewashed villages, and welcoming locals – Portugal is waiting for you.

Day 2: Friday, March 6, 2026 Lisbon, Portugal - Tour Begins Say hello to Lisbon, Portugal's capital and a city full of authenticity, where old customs and ancient history intermix with cultural entertainment. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 3: Saturday, March 7, 2026 Lisbon Choose how you want to explore Lisbon today because it's your choice! Discover the art and tradition of Portuguese sidewalks during a locally led walking tour -OR- venture with your Tour Manager on foot and discover the city through the lens of the businesses and streets connected with the country's most loved fish, bacalhau (salted codfish). After, travel to Belem and see the iconic Belem Tower (UNESCO). View the façade of the 16th-century Jeronimos Monastery* (UNESCO) and learn about the importance of this iconic site. Tonight, you may choose to join an optional tour to listen to local artists perform traditional Fado music, a UNESCO intangible cultural heritage highlight. (B)

Day 4: Sunday, March 8, 2026 Lisbon - Evora Today, make your way through Portugal's charming countryside. Visit a family-owned cork factory, where you'll learn about the product's importance to the local economy and why Portugal is the world's top cork producer. Your journey then takes you

to Evora (UNESCO) – the "Museum City of Portugal." In the afternoon, take time to explore this medieval walled city and see its well-preserved Roman temple up close. (B)

Day 5: Monday, March 9, 2026 Evora - Lagos Journey to the stunning coasts of the Algarve - the southernmost region of Portugal. On the way, visit a local gin distillery. Learn how one man took a homemade drink and implemented traditional Portuguese stills and local ingredients to craft a premium gin. Savor the flavors of these botanicals before continuing your journey south. This afternoon, keep the day balanced and fruity at a winery. Indulge in full-bodied wines from the Alentejo region during a winery tour, tasting, and light lunch before continuing on your drive. Later, switch the rich taste of local wine and spirits for salty ocean air in Algarve. This evening, explore the historic resort town of Lagos, where Moorish and Renaissance influences meet towering seaside cliffs. Many celebrated voyagers began their explorations from this bustling port city. (B, L)

Day 6: Tuesday, March 10, 2026 Lagos It's your day to experience the Algarve on your own. Geraniums, carnellias, and oleanders grow alongside fig, orange, and almond trees, while brightly colored fishing boats bob in the sea. Protected by hills to the north and warmed by the sea, the Algarve's mild climate and beautiful beaches attract visitors from all over the world. You may choose to join an optional boat tour** today that gets you closer to some of the most famous coastal scenery in Portugal. (B. D)

Day 7: Wednesday, March 11, 2026 Lagos - Portimão - Monchique - Lagos This morning venture along the coast to discover the importance of the sardine canning industry in the Algarve. Then, continue to Monchique, a mountain village nestled within a rich landscape, to learn the secrets of regional bread and fruits. Sample them with a savory picnic lunch featuring freshly prepared Algarve seasonal and local specialties. Return to Lagos for an evening at leisure. (B, L)

Day 8: Thursday, March 12, 2026 Lagos - Setúbal - Cascais En route to the Portuguese Riviera, stop in Setúbal a colorful industrial city and one of southern Europe's best-kept secrets. See the *Mercado* (Farmers Market) do Livramento up close. It is considered one of the best fish markets in the world, and it's also rich with displays of fresh fruits and vegetables. Meet local artisans at a family-run shop and learn how the famous hand-painted Portuguese tiles, *azulejos*, are made. Then, head to the Portuguese Riviera. Mansions scattered throughout Cascais and Monte Estoril all hint at this area's history as a haven for exiled European royals and nobility. (B)

Day 9: Friday, March 13, 2026 Cascais - Obidos - Sintra - Cascais Explore the picture-perfect city of Obidos, where

white-washed houses sit snug within medieval city walls, and toast with a ginjinha, a sour cherry liqueur served in a small chocolate cup. Continue on to Sintra (UNESCO), a breathtaking hub that served as the summer residence of Portuguese kings for six centuries. Then, it's your choice! Explore the quaint hilltop village of Sintra and take some time to wander through the winding streets -OR- join a guided tour of the National Palace of Sintra, considered the best-preserved medieval palace in Portugal. Bid Portugal goodbye during dinner in Cascais and celebrate the end of your unforgettable journey. (B, D)

Day 10: Saturday, March 14, 2026 Cascais - Tour Ends Your tour ends today. (B)



Brigadier General (PA) Maureen Weigl was appointed Deputy Adjutant General for Veterans Affairs on April 12, 2021. In this position she supervises the administration of state veterans' programs, reintegration and outreach, and veteran initiatives for more than 700,000 veterans and their dependents. She also oversees the operation of the commonwealth's six veterans' homes.

She retired from the Army in May 2016 after serving for 25 years. Since her retirement, Maureen has become a small business owner and entrepreneur. She also has served with numerous organizations as a military and veterans' advisor. She helps teach military history with Veterans National Education Program, where she teaches military history to JROTC and ROTC through the experiences of those who served. She served on a Veteran task force for the Lieutenant Governor of PA for two years.

Maureen was commissioned as a Distinguished Military Graduate in 1993 through the Reserve Officer Training Corps at the University of Pittsburgh. She served in the Army Reserves, Active Army with the 10th Mountain Division, the New York Army National Guard, the Pennsylvania Army National Guard and National Guard Bureau over her 25-year career. Brig. Gen. (PA) Weigl holds a bachelor's degree in Political Science and Communications from the University of Pittsburgh, a Master's in Business Ethics from Duquesne University, and a Master of Strategic Studies from the US Army War College. 
